Health Safety Measures for In-Person Classes

Effective July 1, 2020

- 1) Instructors are to take a health self-assessment before each day of class. They are not to go to class if they have any COVID symptoms.
- 2) Instructors are to keep accurate attendance each week of class for contact tracing.
- 3) Instructors will have hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes and sanitizing spray as part of their class supplies to use between classes, and available to the parents.
- 4) Parents, students and staff will be asked to hand sanitize coming in and going out of the classroom, and after some activities (such as the parachute).
- 5) Parents and student pairs will sit 6 feet away from each other on rubber squares—one for each student. They will be sanitized after each class.
- 6) Instructors will not use any shared props or toys in class. The parents may bring in a book of their own to read with their child at the start of class, while waiting for class to start.
- 7) Each parent/student pair will receive a sanitized plastic bag containing the supplies for that day. They will use only their bag to get their supplies at the time needed, and return them to that bag. They will turn that in at the end of class. That bag and the contents will be sanitized after classes. The parents will also have the opportunity to purchase their own set of instruments to bring back and forth with them to class for their exclusive use.
- 8) For lesson planning, instead of "group" activities, we will do partner activities.
- 9) The teachers will be waving and blowing kisses to the students instead of giving high-fives or hugs.
- 10) The teacher will wear a mask when entering and exiting the building, and when greeting and dismissing the students. In Tot Rock, Kid Rock I, Kid Rock III, he/she will also wear it if unable to be less than 6 feet apart from anyone in the class for any activity. In Kid Rock II, the instructor will wear a mask the entire class.
